



The Voyager Tour with Benn Robinson

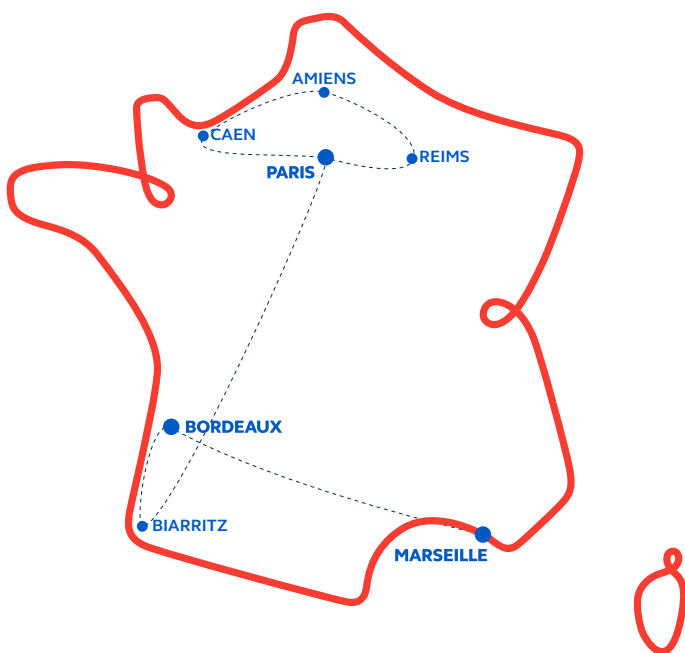

Our Voyager Tour, hosted by Benn Robinson, starts in Marseille for the quarter-finals then heads to the beautiful towns of Saint-Emilion, Bordeaux and Biarritz for a taste of the good life. We travel to Paris for the semi-finals before touring the WW2 memorials of Normandy, Bayeux and the WW1 battlefields of the Somme & Villers-Bretonneux.

Finally we visit Reims and the world-famous Champagne region before finishing in Paris for the final.

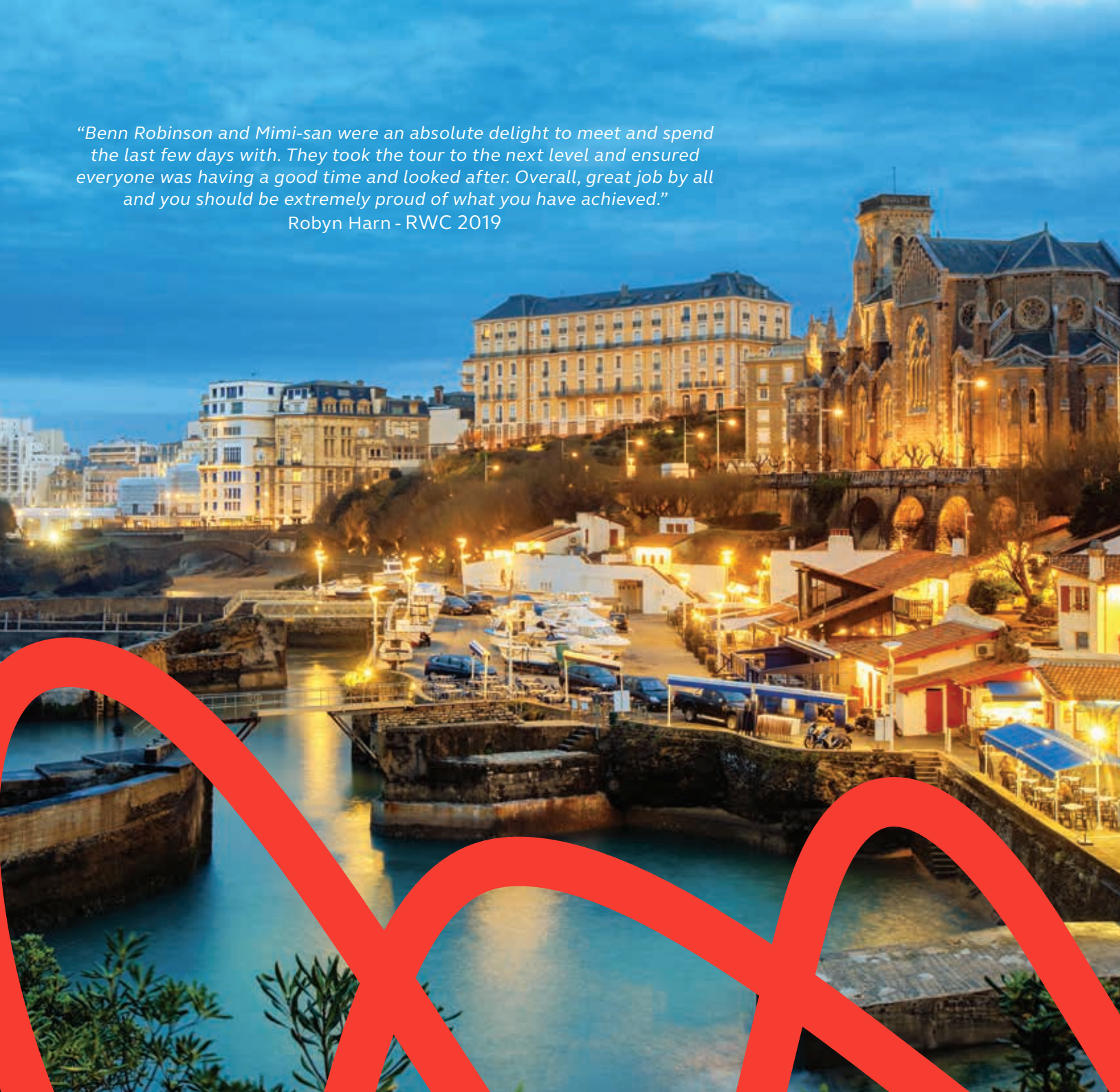
